GOALS AND ASPIRATIONS:

Awards:

For a student attending a West Virginia-related college or university, the annual amount of the scholarship is up to \$6,000; for a student attending an out-of-state college or university, the annual amount of the scholarship is up to \$20,000. Awards may be renewed for up to three additional years or until a bachelor's degree is earned, whichever comes first. Renewal is contingent upon maintaining a 3.0 grade point average (on a 4.0 scale) in a full-time undergraduate program and continuation of the program by The Cline Family Foundation.

Awards are for undergraduate study only.

Application:

Interested students must complete the attached application and return it with a current, complete official transcript to Victoria Knight Clay, Westside High School counselor, no later than 2:30 p.m. April 11, 2014.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied. Therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential.

Selection of Recipients:

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, and unusual personal or family circumstances.

All applicants agree to accept the decision of The Cline Family Foundation scholarship committee.

Applicants will be notified during the senior awards assembly: May 30, 2014 - 6:00 p.m.

Payment of Scholarships:

The Cline Family Foundation will process the scholarships. Payments are made in equal installments on August 16 and December 30. Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student's account. If the student withdraws from school, the scholarship monies must be returned to The Cline Family Foundation.

Obligations:

Recipients are required to supply The Cline Family Foundation with complete transcripts when requested and to notify The Cline Family Foundation of any changes of address, school enrollment or other relevant information.

Revisions:
